


2014 – 2015 Mathematics Curriculum Flowchart


Developmental Math Courses (no college credit)

By placement test, students can place into MATH 015, MATH 020 or MATH 030.



Non Math - Intensive Courses


By placement test, students can place into MATH 100, MATH 101 (may co-enroll in Math 020N if the placement score ranges from 63 to 75 on the Elementary Algebra Domain), MATH 102 or MATH 103c.



Check to make sure that Math 103c transfers to the student's desired four year college, and that your program accepts your Math 10x course.

Math - Intensive Courses

By placement test, students can place into MATH 112, MATH 114H, MATH 110 or MATH 117H.



Students may take MATH 115H (Sum, Sequence, Series) or MATH 116H (Intro to Limits) for 1 credit as a corequisite to MATH 112, MATH 113 or MATH 114H.

Students may take MATH 118H (Introduction to Experimental Design) for 1 credit as a corequisite to MATH 111 or MATH 117H.

Higher Level Math Courses

By placement test, students can place into MATH 150 or MATH 151.
